TASTING NOTES

Our Limited Selection Cabernet Sauvignon is crafted to showcase the best fruit of a particular vintage. After our meticulous sorting process, the fruit from specific blocks of our vineyards are fermented and aged separately in barrel. Only the best barrels are selected for the Limited Selection blend. The 2010 vintage exhibits heady aromas of plum, cherry and sweet spice. The bright fruit and acidity dance on the palate while the soft vanilla-oak notes and silky tannins weave a complex, lingering finish.

VINEYARD NOTES

The fruit for this Cabernet Sauvignon was harvested on October 16 from 20- to 30-year-old vines in Dry Creek Valley. Planted in rocky, well-drained soil, this well-respected vineyard boasts the perfect conditions for growing Cabernet Sauvignon. 2010 proved to be a low-yield vintage, but the limited amount of Cabernet from this vineyard was absolutely stunning and worthy of featuring solo in our Limited Selection Cabernet program.
