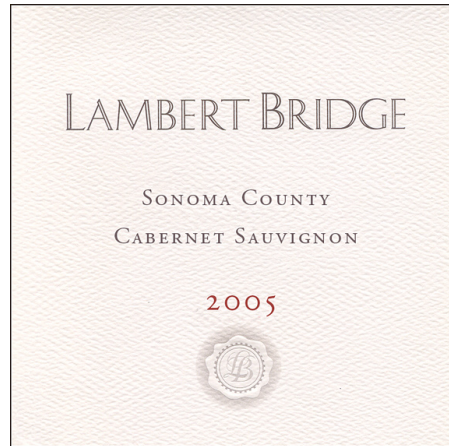


LAMBERT BRIDGE

2005 CABERNET SAUVIGNON, SONOMA COUNTY

Our 2005 Cabernet Sauvignon is gorgeous! It is a dark ruby on its way to a deep inky color. It has a beautifully rich nose brimming with ripe blackberry, currant, cassis and sweet toasty oak. A rich and balanced mouth feel, this wine is ample, round, forward and very complex. Twenty months of bottle aging has allowed this Cabernet Sauvignon to fully develop its flavors of ripe black fruit, lilac, violet, nutmeg, clove, and sweet anise. Aging in 100% French oak adds rich tannin that rounds out the palate. It is delicious today and will hold for many years of enjoyment.

The 2005 vintage was a wonderful one! It had consistent weather that provided our Cabernet Sauvignon fruit with a deep and full maturity. It has great tannin and acid structure. A true treasure and a must in your cellar! We recommend serving the 2005 Cabernet Sauvignon with classic oven roasted filet of beef, wild mushroom bruschetta and pan seared duck breast with cherry sauce.

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
