The wine offers mouth-filling weight and is silky on the palate, with the French oak providing nuances of dark baking spice and sweet vanilla. Bright acidity and the supple yet firm tannins promise many years of graceful aging without compromising enjoyment today. In fact, one of the pleasures of this wine is how DELICIOUS it is right now. Just pop a cork and we think you will agree!

We recommend serving the 2006 Cabernet Sauvignon with classic bacon wrapped filet mignon or pan seared duck breast with lentils du puy.
