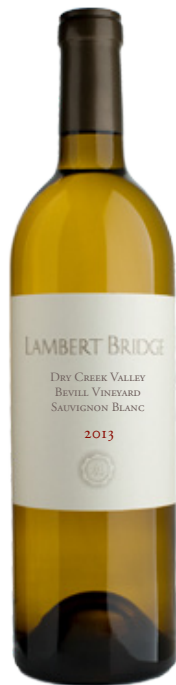

TASTING NOTES

Abundant citrus characters of grapefruit, kumquat and Meyer lemon fill your glass and coalesce with tropical kiwi and lychee fruit. Notes of delicate hibiscus and sweet hay linger. The bright entry evolves to a lengthy mid-palate and a crisp finish that persists with subtle notes of lemon blossom.

VINEYARD NOTES

At the edge of Dry Creek Valley, Bevill Vineyard enjoys morning fog and afternoon sun, a climate that is well suited to this grape variety. The vines grow very consistently aided by careful canopy management. With well-draining soils of gravel and loam the fruit achieves concentration and balance.
