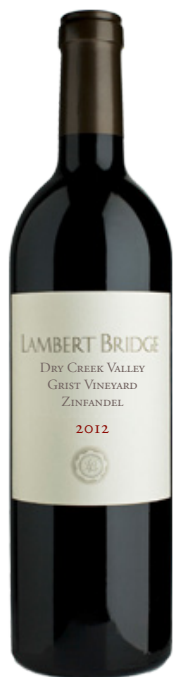

TASTING NOTES

Our 2012 Grist Zinfandel is bursting with dark fruit aromas of black raspberry, forest berry and bramble berry that meld with sweet oak and pepper spice. The palate delivers on what the nose promises with a lush gentle entry, long mid-palate, well integrated tannins and a lingering finish.

VINEYARD NOTES

Grist Vineyard is 1200 feet above the valley floor on Bradford Mountain. It is an organically grown old vine Zinfandel vineyard with red volcanic soils and head pruned vines, which is a traditional training method for this variety. We hand sort the fruit and send 100% whole berries to the tank which moderates tannins and intensifies fruit forward character to make a rich, structured and balanced wine.
